With reference to your application Dated 01/01/2024 and subsequent school inspection in this regard, I here by convey the grant of Recognition to Ananya International School Bhukodihalli, Kaginele Road NH-4 Haveri for class I to VIII standard for the period of 3 year from the academic year 2023-24 to in compliance to section 18 of Right of Children to Free and Complusory Education Act, 2009 & rule of the state of Karnataka

The above recognition is subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. The temporary recognition accorded to the school is valid from the academic year to 2023-24 and is to be renewed at an interval of every 3 years.
- 2. The grant of recognition is available initially for for classes I to VIII standard and to be extended for secondary /Senior secondary classes subsequently in due course of time.
- 3. The school shall abide by the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education act, 2009 and the rules of the state of Karnataka.
- 4. The school shall admit in pre-school / class I to VIII the extent of 25 % of the strength in each class, children belonging to weaker Section and Disadvantaged Group in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.
- 5. The school shall maintain a separate bank account for the purpose of reimbursement.
- 6. The school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parent or guardian to any screening procedure.

- 7. The school shall not deny admission to any child,
 - a. For lack of age proof if such admission if such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed for admission.
 - b.On the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
- 8. The school shall ensure that,
 - a. No child admitted to be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in school.
 - b. No child to be subjected to physical punishment or medical harassment.
 - c. No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
 - d.Inclusion of students with disabilities / special need as per provision of the state of Karnataka.
 - e. the teachers are recruited with minimum qualification as laid under the Education act of Government of Karnataka.
 - f. The teachers perform his duties specified under the rules of state act.
 - The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
 - 10. The school shall maintain the standards and norms as specified in rule/ clause of the state Act.
 - 11. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the name of school.
 - 12. The school building plan must have been approved by the current rules or G. Os.
 - The school building or other structures and the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development. Construction work within the compound should not carried out in school working hours and safety measures in all respect are under whole responsibility of the managements.
 - 13. The school is run by a society registered under the Registration act of Karnataka or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force.
 - 14. The school is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persoans.
 - 15. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Charted Accountant and proper account statement should be prepared.
 - 16. The school shall furnish such reports and information as may be required by the competent authority from time to time and shall comply with such instructions of the State Government or the competent authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.
 - 17. Kannada language shall be taught as a subject from in standards I to X in all schools notified under the Education Act of Government of Karnataka from the current academic session. Recognition is granted.
 - 18. The school shall abided by the provisions of the State Education Act.
 - 19. The certificates of recognition issued by the department shall be subject to the fulfillment of deficiencies if any pointed out by the department at ant stage/time.
 - 20. The management shall rectify the deficiencies pointed out in infrastructure or administration by the
 - 21. The management shall apply for renewal of recognition three months before the expiry of this order to Deputy Director of Public Instruction , Haveri Dist, Haveri.

- 22. The management shall follow the directions issued by the Government/ Department from time to time keeping in view of the safety and security of the children and the overall administration of the school.
- 23. The recognition shall be withdrawn if any contravention of the provisions of the Act, Rule or the conditions of the recognition are found and proved.
- 24. The school management shall have to full responsibility if any court cases arises this regard. The management is not entitled to seek affiliation of other Board without obtaining NOC from the Concerned State Authority.
